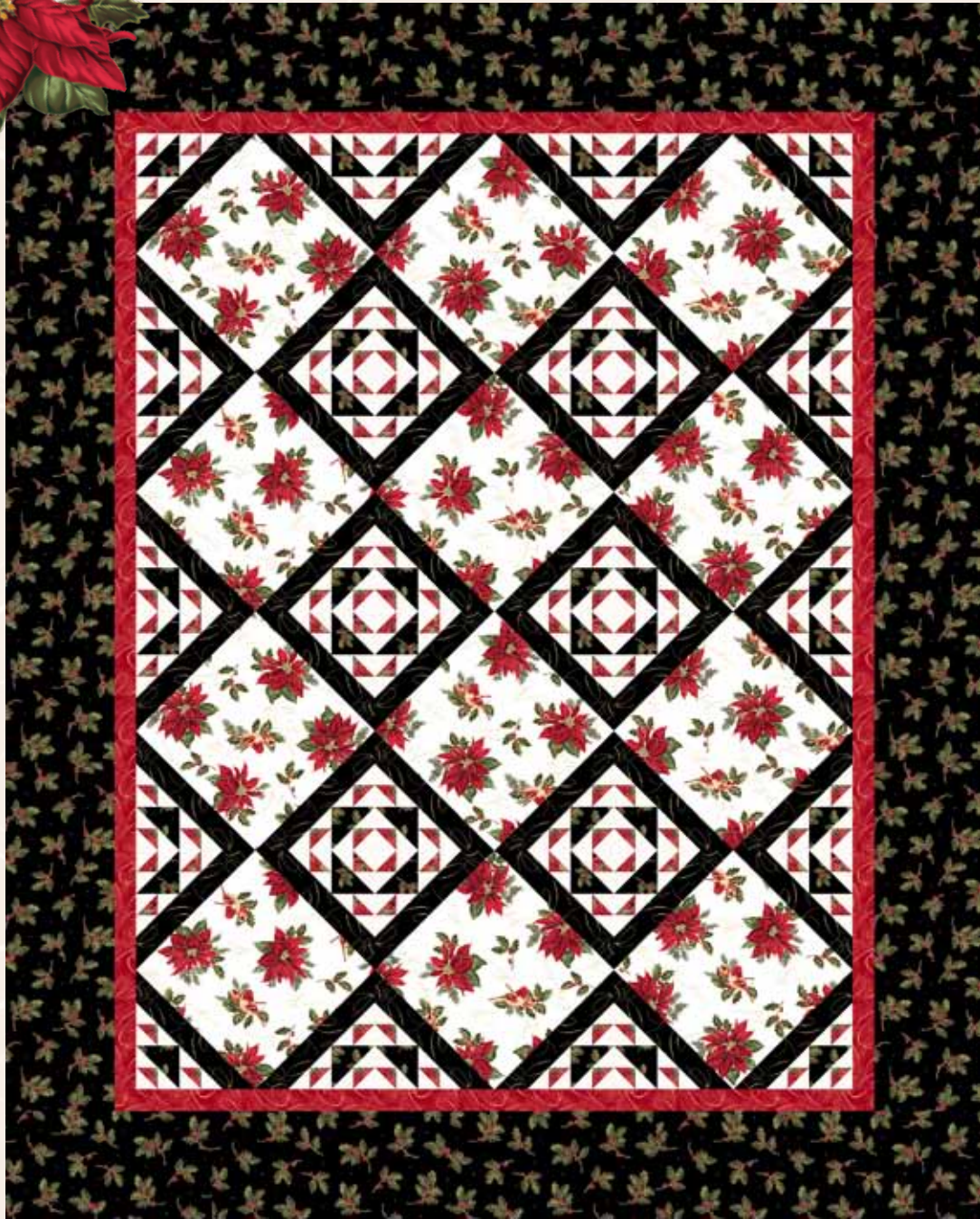

## Cutting

Fabric A MAS2217-OW  
Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips into:  
(72) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut (9) 2-3/8" strips into:  
(144) 2-3/8" squares,  
cut diagonally once to make 288 triangles

Fabric B MAS3008-J  
Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips into:  
(72) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric C MAS3011-J  
Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips into:  
(24) 3-7/8" squares  
cut diagonally once to make 48 triangles  
Cut (8) 8-1/2" strips for outer border  
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips for binding

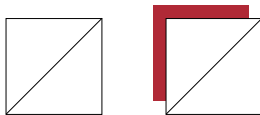
Fabric D MAS3015-J  
Cut (3) 15" strips, into:  
(48) 15" x 2-1/2" pieces

Fabric E MAS3009-W  
Cut (4) 12-3/4" strips into:  
(12) 12-3/4" squares

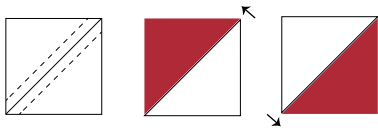
Fabric F MAS3015-R  
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips for inner border

## Construction

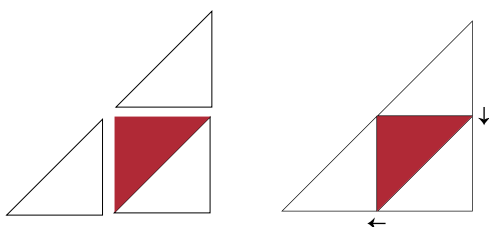
1. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the Fabric A 2-1/2" squares. Place (1) Fabric A square right sides together with (1) 2-1/2" square of Fabric B.



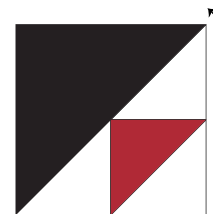
2. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Open and press seams towards Fabric B. Trim each to a 2" square. Make 144.



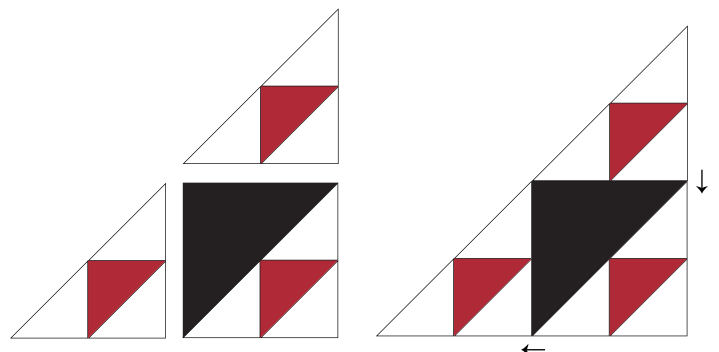
3. Sew (2) 2-3/8" Fabric A triangles to the step 1 square as shown below. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Make 144.



4. Sew a Fabric C 3-7/8" triangle to a step 3 unit as shown below. Press towards Fabric C. The block should measure 3-1/2" x 3-1/2". Make 48.

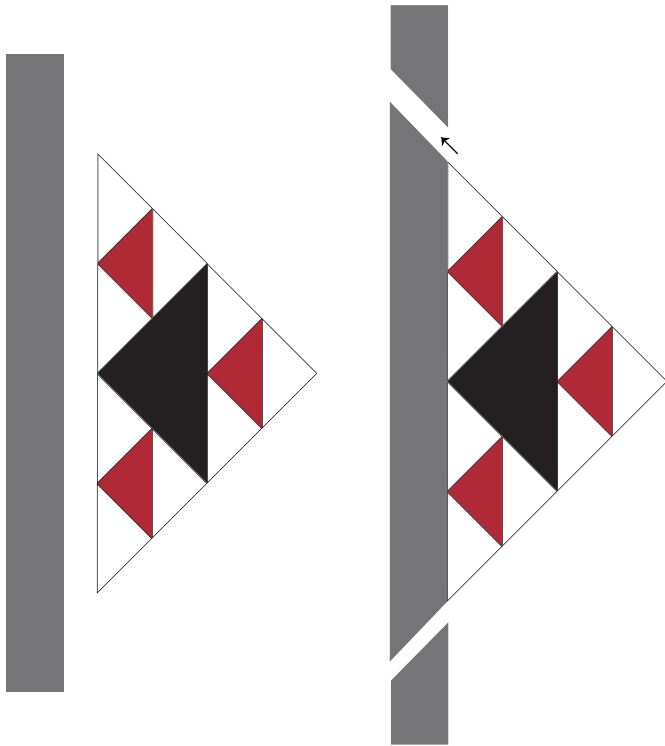


5. Sew the remaining units from step 2 to the step 3 units as shown below. Press in the direction of the arrows. Make 48.

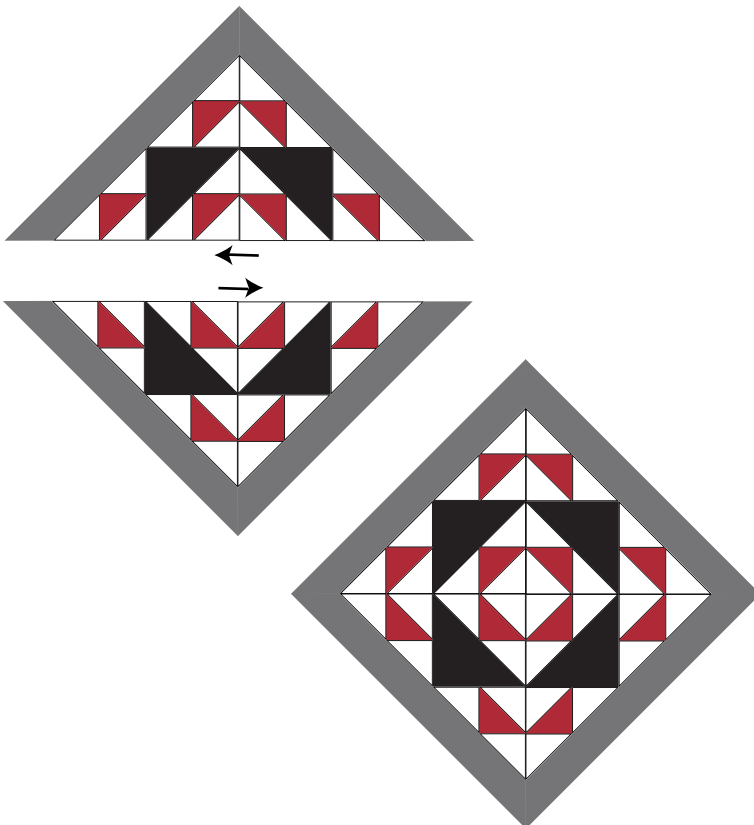


# Construction

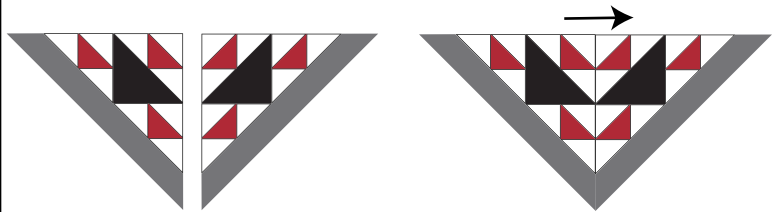
6. Sew the Fabric D 2-1/2" x 15" strip to the unit from step 5 as shown, centering the triangle unit on the dark strip. Press in the direction of the arrow. Trim to create a triangle. Make 48.



7. Sew (4) triangle units from step 6 together to make a block. Press seams as shown. The block should measure 12-3/4" square. Make 6.



8. Sew 2 units from step 5 together to make 10 setting triangle units. Press in one direction. Note: you should have 4 triangles units from step 5 leftover for corners.



9. Referring to the diagram below, sew the quilt top together in 6 diagonal rows; pressing towards the setting square. Sew the rows together and add the corner units. Press in one direction.

10. Sew on the inner and outer border. Quilt and bind.

Backing  
MAS3012-R .... 5-3/4 yards
