## Fabric 1 FWDQUG01-NR

Fussy cut (7) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ "' squares.
Fussy cut (12) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Fabric 2 FWDQUG02-NR
Cut (2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times 621 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (2) 8 " $\times 381 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric 3 FWDQUG11-NT
Cut (32) $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut (64) 3" squares.
Fabric 4 FWDAGP-B
Cut (11) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut (1) $21 / 2$ " square.
Fabric 5 FWDAGP-R
Cut (11) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut (1) $21 / 2$ " square.
Fabric 6 FWDQUG11-BN
Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (WOF) strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Cut (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Cut (8) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric 7 FWDQUG10-B
Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} \mathfrak{1}^{\prime} \times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2 \prime$ " $\times 20$ " strip.
Fabric 8 FWDQUG04-B
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Fabric 9 FWDQUG05-TB
Cut (1) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " strip.
Fabric 10 FWDQUG03-B
Cut (1) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Cut (32) 4" squares.
Fabric 11 FWDQUG08-R
Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " strip.

Fabric 12 FWDQUG06-TR
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Cut (6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
Fabric 13 FWDQUG03-R
Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2 \prime \prime \times 20$ " strip.
Fabric 14 FWDQUG10-R
Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Fabric 15 FWDQUG04-R
Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Cut (64) 3" x 4" strips.
Cut (8) $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Cut (8) $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## Backing

Cut (2) 60" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $60^{\prime \prime} \times 84^{\prime \prime}$ for the backing.

## Star Blocks:

1. Use your favorite method, paper piecing or using the templates provided, to make the star points units (Fig. 1). Use (64) 3" $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 15 strips,
(64) 3" Fabric 3 squares and
(32) 4" Fabric 10 squares to make (32) star point units. Trim to measure $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.

2. Sew one star point unit to the top and bottom of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 1 square to make one star block middle column. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 3 square to the top and bottom of one star point unit to make the side column. Repeat to make a second side column. Sew the strips to the star block middle column to complete on Block One (Fig. 2).

3. Repeat Steps 2 to make eight star blocks total. Trim to measure 10-1/2" square.

## Corner Blocks:

4. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 20$ " Fabric 12 strip to each side of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 6 strip, lengthwise. Sub-cut this strip set into (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \times 1 / 2 "$ pieced strips (Fig. 3).

5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " Fabric 6 strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 1 square. Sew (1) pieced strip to the top and bottom of the $41 / 2$ " Fabric 1 square to make one corner block center (Fig. 4). Repeat to make four corner block centers.

6. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 15 strip to each side of (1) corner block center.

Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 8$ " Fabric 15 strip to the top and bottom of the corner block center to complete one Corner Block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make four Corner Blocks total. Trim to measure 8" square.


## Sashing:

7. Sew one $2 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times$ WOF Fabric 6 , Fabric 7, Fabric 8, Fabric 9, and Fabric 10 strips together, lengthwise, to make one strip set. Repeat with the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make a second strip set. Sub-cut the strip sets into nineteen $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Blue sashing strips (Fig. 6)

8. Repeat Step 7 using the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ 20 " Fabric 11, Fabric 12, Fabric 13, Fabric 14 and Fabric 15 strips to make nineteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Red sashing strips (Fig. 7).

9. Place one $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 4 square on top of one $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 5 square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 8). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9) to make two halfsquare triangles (Fig. 10). Trim blocks to measure $21 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make twenty-two half-square trinagles. Trim to measure $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

Quilt Assembly (Follow the quilt layout diagram while assembling the quilt top):
10. Sew together three half-square triangles, two Red sashing strips, one Blue sashing strip and one $21 / 2$ " Fabric 5 square together to make the top sashing row.
11. Sew four half-square triangles, two Blue sashing strips and one Red sashing strip together to make one Blue sashing row. Repeat to make a second Blue sashing row.
12. Sew four half-square triangles, two Red sashing strips and one Blue sashing strip together to make one Red sashing row. Repeat to make a second Red sashing row.
13. Sew one $21 / 2$ " Fabric 4 square, two Blue sashing strips, three half-square triangles and one Red sashing strip together to make the bottom sashing row.
14. Sew two Blue sashing strips, two Block Ones, two Red sashing strips and one $101 / 2$ " Fabric 1 square together to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five.
15. Sew two Red sashing strips, two $101 / 2$ " Fabric 1 squares, two Blue sashing strips and one Block One together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
16. Sew the five rows and six sashing strips together to make the quilt top.
17. Sew one $8^{\prime \prime} \times 62 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 2 strip to each side of the quilt top.
18. Sew one Corner Block to each end of one 8 " $x$ $381 / 2$ " Fabric 2 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric 7 binding strips together, end-to-end with $45^{\circ}$ seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.
