## Cutting

From Fabric A, cut (2) 14 1/2" squares.
From Fabric B, cut (2) $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Also from Fabric B, cut (1) piece using Templates 1 and 3.

From Fabric C, cut (2) 14 1/2" squares. Also from Fabric C, cut (1) piece using Template 2.

From Fabrics D, E and F, cut (1) $141 / 2$ " square.
The 14 1/2" squares are the background pieces which all the other curved pieces will be appliqued onto.

Also from Fabric D, cut (1) piece using Templates 1 and 5. From Fabric E, cut (1) piece using Template 1. From Fabric F cut (1) piece using Template 4.

From Fabric G, cut (1) piece (each) using Templates 1, 3 and 5 and cut (2) using Template 4.

From Fabric H, cut (1) piece using Template 2 and 3.
From Fabric I, cut (1) piece (each) using Templates 2, 4 and 5. Also cut (5) $21 / 4$ " strips (WOF) for binding.

From Fabric J cut (1) piece (each) using Templates 2, 3 and 5.

From Freezer Paper cut 4 pieces using Template 1, minus the $1 / 4$ " curved edge. Cut 4 pieces using Template 3, minus the $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ inside curve. Cut 4 pieces using Template 4 , minus the $1 / 4$ " inside diagonal edge. Cut 4 pieces using Template 5, minus the $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ curved edge.

Using a glue stick, adhere the matte side of the Freezer Paper to the backside of the corresponding fabric shape. Keep straight edges even allowing the fabric to extend $1 / 4$ " beyond the curved edges, of the Freezer Paper. Fold and iron back this $1 / 4$ " of fabric. It will stick to the wax of the freezer paper to help hold it in place.

Place the applique pieces on the $141 / 2$ " squares, using the photo for fabric placement. Iron...this will lightly adhere the top piece to the bottom square. Zigzag in place (along the curves) using clear mono-filament thread and a very narrow stitch width. Gently remove the paper. It may be necessary to trim (grade) the seam allowances of the darker fabrics to avoid them showing through the lighter.

Once all the blocks are completely appliqued, sew in rows of 3, making a nine patch.

Layer top with the batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with Fabric I.
