## Paper Piecing Knowledge Required

Creating the Pattern: The paper pieced block is broken into 4 sections in order for it to be easily reproduced on your home printer. Construct the block by taping the 4 sections together aligning the dotted lines and corresponding numbers. The square blocks should measure $121 / 2$ " unfinished (to the dotted line) or 12 " finished (to the solid line). Twelve blocks need to be created.

Letter each block with a letter, A thru L, that will correspond to the location of the block within the quilt; see diagram below. Remember, to stitch on the printed side and place the fabric on the unprinted side therefore the pattern is a reverse image,

Paper Piecing the Blocks: Specific fabric placement is critical in this pattern to create the ribbon effect. The following chart and diagram outlines where each fabric and respective blocks are used.

## Quilt Construction:

Cut the sashing pieces, You will need 31 sashing pieces cut $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ and 20 cornerstone pieces cut $11 / 2$ " x $11 / 2 "$. The blue/brown quilt uses Rust J7051 \#39 for the sashing and Gold J7051\#47 for the cornerstones. The red/green color way uses Hunter G8565 \#60 for the sashing and Cream G8565 \#33 for the cornerstones.

Sew the sashing, cornerstone and paper pieced blocks into rows. Starting from the top the first row will include cornerstone and sashing pieces. The second row will be sashing pieces and blocks. Continue until all rows are sewn and then join the rows to complete the quilt center. Remove the paper from the seam allowances once the blocks have been sewn and all the paper once the quilt center is complete.

Bordering this quilt requires some interesting piecing for the side borders as the ribbon effect created in the quilt's center continues out into the side borders. The diagonal seams are sewn in a similar manner to continuous binding. Refer to the diagram below as how to create these diagonal seams. The diagram shows sewing piece \#1 to \#2. Repeat the process for sewing piece \#2 to \#3 and so on. The length of each piece is given in the following chart. The left and right borders are sewn differently, so create each separately.

Left Border: Numbering and sewing starts from the quilt BOTTOM (chart continues on the following page)

## Left Border:



Follow the diagrams above to construct the left side border
A. Place fabric \#1, right side up, and fabric \#2 right side down, with $1 / 4^{\prime}$ extending beyond each fabric.

Orient per diagram
B. Sew a diagonal seam in the directions shown
C. Remove excess fabric and press
D. REPEAT with fabric \#2 being right side up and join to fabric \#3, Keep adding fabrics until fabric 5 has been joined to the border

Right Border: Numbering and sewing starts from the quilt BOTTOM

## Right Border:



Follow the diagrams above to construct the right side border.
Note: This border is constructed like the left side, but pay attention to the differences in fabric orientation and seam direction.

Once the side border lengths are sewn, attach them to the quilt sides aligning the ribboning fabrics.
The top and bottom borders are much easier than the sides! The main pieces are cut $31 / 2$ "x $401 / 2$ " and the corners are $31 / 2$ " squares. Sew a square to both ends of the main pieces and then attach to your quilt.

Your quilt top is now complete! Quilt and bind. The Blue/brown color way uses Brown J9001 and the Red/green quilt uses Hunter J9001.
