## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: . Cut three 9 " high x 11 " wide pieces for the large presents. (Directional Fabric)

Fabric B: . Cut three 9 " high x $11^{\prime \prime}$ wide pieces for the large presents. (Directional Fabric)

Fabric C: . Cut seven $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece the strips together to make two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the outer borders.

Fabric D: •Cut one $8^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips and eight $1 \frac{112 " x}{} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the small present ribbons.

- Cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the bows.

Fabric E: • Cut two 9 " high $\times 11^{\prime \prime}$ wide pieces for the large presents. (Directional Fabric)

Fabric F: . Cut one 7" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 7" $\times 8$ " pieces for the small presents.

Fabric G: . Cut one 7" $\times 42$ " strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 7 " $\times 8$ " pieces for the small presents.

Fabric H: •Cut one $12^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sub-cut the strip into twenty $1 \frac{112 "}{} \times 12^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ strips for the vertical sashing.

- Cut eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece the strips together to make five $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the horizontal sashing.

Fabric I: - Cut one $21^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares for the bows. - Cut two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ stirps for the large present ribbons.

- Cut six $21^{1 / 2} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the binding.

Fabric J: $\quad$ Cut twelve $5^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen $5^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and sixteen $5^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

- Cut three $2^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $2^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 10^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ strips and sixteen $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $33^{1 / 1^{\prime \prime}} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut nine $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixty-four $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares and sixteen $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

Backing: . Cut two $71^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make one $71^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$ square.

## Assembly Instructions: <br> Bows

1. Place one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ "Fabric J square on the top left corner of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam.
2. Place another $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J square on the top right corner of the $2^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ Fabric I square, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric

3. Repeat Steps $1-2$ to make sixteen Fabric I bow halves. Repeat Steps $1-2$ to make sixteen Fabric $D$ bow halves using sixteen $2^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I squares and thirty-two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $J$ squares.
4. Sew together two Fabric I bow halves to make one $2^{11 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I bow (Fig. 5). Repeat to make eight Fabric I bows. Sew together two Fabric D bow halves to make eight Fabric D bows (Fig. 6).

10. Measure down from the top of one $7^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F piece 2" and draw a line (Fig. 13). Cut along the line. 11. Sew one $1^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the bottom edge of the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F piece. Sew the $5^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ " Fabric $F$ piece to the bottom of the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to make one small present (Fig. 14).
12. Cut the small present in half as shown in Figure 15 . Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$ " Fabric $D$ strip to the right side edge of the small present-left half (Fig. 16). Sew the small present-right half to the other side of the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to complete one small present (Fig. 16). Trim the present to measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ high $\times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, centering the Fabric $D$ vertical strip in the middle.
13. Repeat Steps $10-12$ to make four Fabric $F$ small presents and four Fabric $G$ small presents.
14. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 \prime}$ "Fabric J strip to each side of the eight Fabric D bows to make eight small present tops Sew one small present top to each small present block to make one $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8{ }^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Fabric $F$ and four Fabric $G$ small presents.

18. Refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew together four $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ assorted present blocks and five $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ "Fabric H strips, alternating them to make one block row. Repeat to make four block rows.
19. Sew together the four block rows and five $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $H$ strips, alternating them to make the $531 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square quilt top.
20. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top
21. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
