Cutting Instructions:

• Cut three 9" high x 11" wide pieces for the large presents. (Directional Fabric)

• Cut three 9" high x 11" wide pieces for the large presents. (Directional Fabric)

Fabric C: • Cut seven $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and two $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the outer borders.

• Cut one 8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1½" x 8" strips and eight 1½" x 7½" strips for the small present ribbons.

• Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2½" squares for the bows.

• Cut two 9" high x 11" wide pieces for the large presents. (Directional Fabric)

• Cut one 7" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 7" x 8" pieces for the small presents.

• Cut one 7" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 7" x 8" pieces for the small presents.

Fabric H:

- Cut one $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into twenty $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the vertical sashing.
- Cut eight $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make five $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 53\frac{1}{2}" strips for the horizontal sashing.

Fabric I:

- Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2½" squares for the bows.
- Cut two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" stirps for the large present ribbons.
- Cut six 2½" x 42" strips for the binding.

Fabric J:

- Cut twelve 5" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 5" x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sixteen 5" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sixteen 2" x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 3½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2½" x 3½" strips.
- Cut nine $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixty-four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and sixteen $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Backing:

• Cut two 71" x 42" strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make one 71" x 71" square.

Assembly Instructions:

Bows


- 1. Place one 1½" Fabric J square on the top left corner of one 2½" Fabric I square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.
- 2. Place another 1½" Fabric J square on the top right corner of the 2½" Fabric I square, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam to make one half of the bow.
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make sixteen Fabric I bow halves. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make sixteen Fabric D bow halves using sixteen 2½" Fabric I squares and thirty-two 1½" Fabric J squares.
- 4. Sew together two Fabric I bow halves to make one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I bow (Fig. 5). Repeat to make eight Fabric I bows. Sew together two Fabric D bow halves to make eight Fabric D bows (Fig. 6).















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
Large Presents

- 5. Cut one 9" x 11" Fabric A piece in half to make two 9" x 5½" units (Fig. 7). Do not mix up the left half and right half. Sew one 1½" x 9" Fabric I strip to the right side edge of the Fabric A-left half (Fig. 8). Sew the Fabric A-right half to the other side of the 1½" x 9 Fabric I strip to make one A/I present (Fig. 9). Trim the present to measure 8½" high x 10½" wide, centering the Fabric I strip in the middle.
- 6. Repeat Step 5 to make three Fabric A presents, three Fabric B presents and two Fabric E presents.
- 7. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the eight Fabric I bows. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top of the bow strips to make the large present tops (Fig. 10).
- 8. Sew the large present tops to each of the large presents from Step 5 (Fig. 11).
- 9. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the large present blocks to make eight assorted $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " large present blocks (Fig. 12).



- 10. Measure down from the top of one 7" x 8" Fabric F piece 2" and draw a line (Fig. 13). Cut along the line.
- 11. Sew one 1½" x 8" Fabric D strip to the bottom edge of the 2" x 8" Fabric F piece. Sew the 5" x 8" Fabric F piece to the bottom of the 1½" x 8" Fabric D strip to make one small present (Fig. 14).
- 12. Cut the small present in half as shown in Figure 15. Sew one 1½" x 7½" Fabric D strip to the right side edge of the small present-left half (Fig. 16). Sew the small present-right half to the other side of the 1½" x 7½" Fabric D strip to complete one small present (Fig. 16). Trim the present to measure 6½" high x 7½" wide, centering the Fabric D vertical strip in the middle.
- 13. Repeat Steps 10-12 to make four Fabric F small presents and four Fabric G small presents.
- 14. Sew one 2" x 2½" Fabric J strip to each side of the eight Fabric D bows to make eight small present tops. Sew one small present top to each small present block to make one 7½" x 8½" block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Fabric F and four Fabric G small presents.



- 15. Sew one 5" x 8½" Fabric J strip to each side of one small present block. Sew one 5" x 16½" Fabric J Strip to the top and bottom of the small present to make one 161/2" block (Fig. 18). Repeat with the remaining small presents.
- 16. To make the small present blocks tilt as shown, use a 12½" ruler and place it on one Fabric F small present block, tilting the ruler (Fig. 19). Trim the small present block to measure 121/2" square with the present tilted to the left.
- 17. Repeat Step 16 to make two Fabric F present blocks and two Fabric G present blocks tilting to the left and two Fabric F present blocks and two Fabric G present blocks tilting to the right (Fig. 20).






18. Refer to the guilt photo for block placement and sew together four 12 1/2" assorted present blocks and five 1½" x 12½" Fabric H strips, alternating them to make one block row. Repeat to make four block rows.

- 19. Sew together the four block rows and five 1½" x 53½" Fabric H strips, alternating them to make the $53\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " square quilt top.
- 20. Sew one 5½" x 53½" Fabric C strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 5½" x 63½" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

21. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

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
