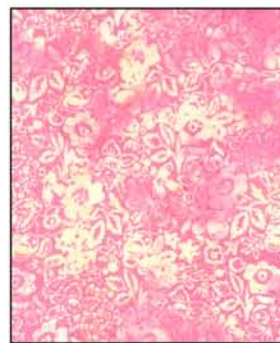

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

From Fabric A, cut:

- (4) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric B, cut:

- (4) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric C, cut:

- (4) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric D, cut:

- (7) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof outer-border strips

From Fabric E, cut:

- (6) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips; cut into (96) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

- (6) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips; cut into (40) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles *and* (40) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric G, cut:

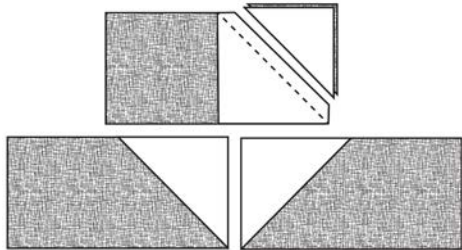
- (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips; cut 1 of the strips into (20) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (8) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof binding strips

From Fabric H, cut:

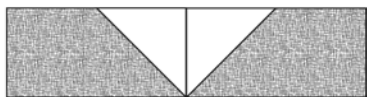
- (9) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips; cut into (144) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (28) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips

Construction

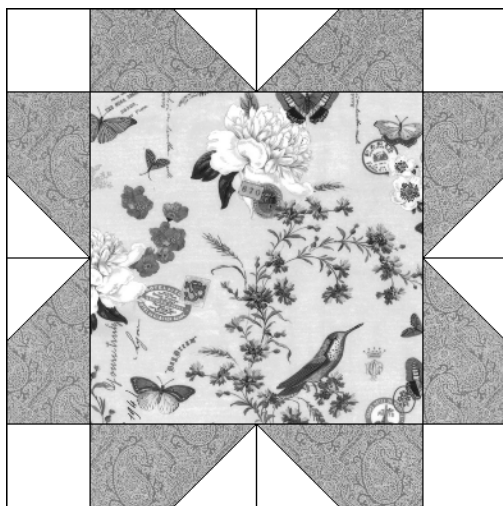
1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each fabric H $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place a marked square on one end of a fabric E rectangle, right sides together. Sew along the marked line and trim away the corner fabric, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Repeat to make a total of 48 units and 48 reversed units.



2. Sew one unit and one reversed unit together to make a side unit. Make 48 units.



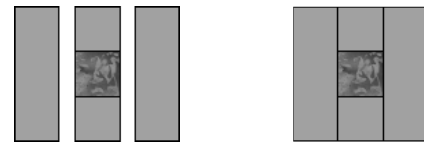
3. Lay out four fabric H squares, four side units, and one fabric A square as shown. Sew the pieces together into rows and then join the rows to complete the block. Make a total of four blocks using the fabric A squares.



4. Repeat step 3 to make four blocks using the fabric B squares and four blocks using the fabric C squares.

5. Join two fabric H $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips and one fabric G $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strip to make a strip set. Make 11 strip sets. Cut the strip sets into (31) $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide sashing strips.

6. Lay out two fabric F rectangles, two fabric F squares, and one fabric G square as shown. Join the pieces to make a sashing block. The block should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 20 blocks.



7. Join four sashing strips from step 5 and three blocks, beginning with a sashing strip and alternating them as shown in the photo to make a block row. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips. Make four rows.

8. Join four sashing blocks from step 6 and three sashing strips from step 5, beginning with a block and alternating them as shown in the photo to make a sashing row. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips. Make five rows.

9. Sew the block rows and sashing rows together, beginning with a sashing row and alternating them as shown in the photo. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing rows. The quilt top should measure $48\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ ".

7. Join the remaining fabric H $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips end to end. From the pieced strip, cut two $63\frac{1}{2}$ " long strips and sew them to the sides of the quilt top. Then cut two $50\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top for the inner border.

8. Join the fabric D strips end to end. From the pieced strip, cut two $65\frac{1}{2}$ " long strips and sew them to the sides of the quilt top. Then cut two $60\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top for the outer border.

11. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the fabric G $2\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide strips, bind the edges to finish.

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

From Fabric A, cut:

- (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " outer-border strips
- (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " outer-border strips

From Fabric B, cut:

- (20) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric C, cut:

- (4) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric D, cut:

- (40) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- (20) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric E, cut:

- (32) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

- (2) 1" x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (2) 1" x $33\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (2) 1" x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (2) 1" x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (5) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42" binding strips

From Fabric G, cut:

- (48) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (20) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
