## Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).
From Fabric A, cut:

- (4) $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares

From Fabric B, cut:

- (4) $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares

From Fabric C, cut:

- (4) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric D, cut:
-(7) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof outer-border strips
From Fabric E, cut:

- (6) $41 / 2$ " x wof strips; cut into (96) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

- (6) $11 / 2$ " x wof strips; cut into (40) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $31 / 2$ "
rectangles and (40) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
From Fabric G, cut:
- (12) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips; cut 1 of the strips into (20) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (8) $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " x wof binding strips

From Fabric H, cut:

- (9) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips; cut into (144) $21 / 2$ " squares
- (28) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips


## Construction

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each fabric $\mathrm{H} 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place a marked square on one end of a fabric $E$ rectangle, right sides together. Sew along the marked line and trim away the corner fabric, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Repeat to make a total of 48 units and 48 reversed units.


2.Sew one unit and one reversed unit together to make a side unit. Make 48 units.


3.. Lay out four fabric H squares, four side units, and one fabric A square as shown. Sew the pieces together into rows and then join the rows to complete the block. Make a total of four blocks using the fabric A squares.


4.Repeat step 3 to make four blocks using the fabric B squares and four blocks using the fabric C squares. fabric G $11 / 2$ "-wide strip to make a strip set. Make 11 strip sets. Cut the strip sets into (31) $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide sashing strips.
6. Lay out two fabric $F$ rectangles, two fabric $F$ squares, and one fabric $G$ square as shown. Join the pieces to make a sashing block. The block should measure $31 / 2$ square. Make 20 blocks.

7. Join four sashing strips from step 5 and three blocks, beginning with a sashing strip and alternating them as shown in the photo to make a block row. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips. Make four rows.
8. Join four sashing blocks from step 6 and three sashing strips from step 5 , beginning with a block and alternating them as shown in the photo to make a sashing row. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips. Make five rows.
9. Sew the block rows and sashing rows together, beginning with a sashing row and alternating them as shown in the photo. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing rows. The quilt top should measure $481 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
7. Join the remaining fabric $\mathrm{H} 1 \frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips end to end. From the pieced strip, cut two $631 / 2$ long strips and sew them to the sides of the quilt top. Then cut two $501 / 2$ strips and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top for the inner border.
8. Join the fabric $D$ strips end to end. From the pieced strip, cut two $651 / 2$ " long strips and sew them to the sides of the quilt top. Then cut two $601 / 2$ strips and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top for the outer border.
11. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the fabric G $21 / 4$ "wide strips, bind the edges to finish.

## Cutting

- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ " outer-border strips
- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ outer-border strips

From Fabric B, cut:

- (20) $31 / 2$ " squares

From Fabric C, cut:

- (4) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabric D, cut:

- (40) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- (20) $11 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares

From Fabric E, cut:

- (32) $2 ½$ " $\times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

- (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 341 ⁄ 2$ " border strips
-(2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 33 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ border strips
- (2) 1 " $\times 27 ½$ " border strips
-(2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ border strips
- (5) $2 \frac{114 " ~}{4} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ binding strips

From Fabric G, cut:

- (48) $21 / 2$ " squares
- (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ " border strips
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 24 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ border strips
- (20) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
