EART 292 K $21 / 2$ yards
EART $293 \mathrm{Z} \quad 5 / 8$ yard
EART $294 \mathrm{E} \quad 1 / 2$ yard
EART 294 KZ 1 1⁄2 yards
EART 295 E 1 yard
EART 295 YG $1 / 4$ yard
EART 296 B $3 / 4$ yard
EART 296 X $1 / 2$ yard
EART 296 Z 2/3 yard (binding)
BACKING
4 yards of any EART fabric

## Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).
From 290 X, cut:

- (10) $91 / 2$ " x wof strips; cut into (48) $7^{1 / 12 \prime \prime} \times 9^{1 / 2 \prime}$ rectangles (piece 1)

From 292 KB, cut:

- (6) 7 " x wof strips; cut into (48) $41 / 2$ " x $7^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (piece 2)
- (6) 6 " x wof strips; cut into (48) 5 " x 6" rectangles (piece 4)


## From 295 E, cut:

- (3) 7 " x wof strips; cut into (48) 2 " x 7" rectangles (piece 3)
- (1) $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strip; cut into (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (block D) and (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles (block C)

From 296 B, cut:

- (3) $41 / 2$ " x wof strips; cut into (48) 2 " x $41 / 2$ " rectangles (piece 5)
- (1) $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strip; cut into (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (block D) and (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles (block C)

From 294 KZ, cut:

- (5) $10^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips; cut into (48) $31 / 2$ " x $10^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (piece 6)

From 294 E, cut:

- (2) $61 / 2$ " x wof strips; cut into (48) $11 / 2$ " x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (piece 7 )
From 296 X, cut:
- (3) $5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof strips; cut into (48) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (piece 8)

From 295 YG, cut:

- (1) $71^{1 / 2 "} \times$ wof strip; cut into (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (block D) and (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (block C)

From 291 XB, cut:

- (1) $51 / 2$ " x wof strip; cut into (16) $21 / 2$ x $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (block C)
-(1) $71 / 2$ " x wof strip; cut into (8) $21 / 2$ " x $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (block D)

From 293 Z, cut:

- (9) 2 " x wof strips; cut into (16) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2$ " rectangles (block C) and (16) 2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (block D)

From 296 Z, cut:
-(8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof binding strips

## Block A \& Block B Assembly

1. Make 24 copies of each foundation pattern ( 48 total). The patterns are a mirror image of the finished blocks and do not include a seam allowance around the outside sewing line.
2. Referring to the cutting list, paper piece each block in numerical order using the appropriate fabrics. Make sure the fabrics extend at least $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ beyond the outside sewing line.
3. After adding the last piece, trim the blocks $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ beyond the outside sewing for seam allowance. The blocks should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, including the seam allowances. Make 24 of each block. Do not remove the paper foundation.

## Block C Assembly

4. Using the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ rectangles, sew 291 XB rectangles to both long sides of a 296 B rectangle. Add a 294 YG rectangle and a 295 E rectangle to each side to make the center of the block.
5. Sew a 293 Z 2" x $10^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to opposite sides of the pieced center to complete the block. Repeat the process to make eight of block C. The blocks should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Block D Assembly

6.. Using the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, sew a 295 YG rectangle to the long side of a 296 B rectangle. Add a 291 XB rectangle and then a 295 E rectangle to make the center of the block.
7. Sew a 293 Z 2" x $8^{1 / 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to opposite ends of the pieced center to complete the block. Repeat the process to make eight of block D. The blocks should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Quilt Assembly

8. Referring to the photo and assembly diagram, layout the blocks in eight rows of eight blocks each, alternating and rotating the blocks as shown. Join the blocks into rows and then join the rows. Remove the paper foundations.
9. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide binding strips, bind the edges to finish.
