Basic Instructions

- All seams are sewn right sides together unless otherwise mentioned using a 1/4" seam allowance
- Fabric requirements are based on 42" of usable width.
- Use a removable marking tool for any marks made on the fabric right side. Test for removability.
- We recommend prewashing cotton fabrics before cutting.
- Label your pieces as you cut to avoid mixups.

Cut the Fabrics

L7280 500s /Silver Peacock Gardenia

Fussy cut (4) 13 1/2" x 13 1/2" squares to center the peacocks.



L7281 4s / Black Silver Large Paisley

Cut the following on the LOF.

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x 62 1/2" rectangle. Border

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x 41 1/2" rectangle. Border

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x 28 1/2" rectangle. Border

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x 21 1/2" rectangle. Border

L7284 28s /Silver medallion

Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip on the WOF, sub-cut into: (3) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares




L7282 500s/Silver Flower

Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip on the WOF, sub-cut into: (3) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares



Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Binding

Cut (2) 1 1/2" strips on the WOF, sub-cut into:



J9216 61s Turquoise/Silver

Cut (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut into: (34) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. Sashing Squares



J9216 3s White/Silver

Cut (1) 20 ½" x 29 ½" rectangle. Appliqué background Cut (42) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Sashing



Cut the appliqué shapes

Trace the pattern onto the paper liner of double stick fusible web. Stick to the WS of fabric. Cut along the marked lines.

Cut (7) template F

L7282 500s /Silver Flower

Cut (3) template B

L7283 4s Black/Silver Packed Paisley


L7284 28s Silver/Silver Medallion

Adhere fusible web to WS of fabric prior to cutting.

Cut (3) 1/2" x WOF strips. Stems

Cut (2) 1/4" x WOF strips. Flower Stalk






Sew the Appliquéd Block

Remove the lining paper from the appliqué pieces. Finger press the shapes in place in the order given below on the 20 ½" x 29 ½" appliqué background. When satisfied with the placement fuse in place following the manufacturer's directions.

- 1. 1/2" Stems
- 2. 1/4" Flower Stalks
- 3. Shapes D and E
- 4. Shapes A and C
- 5. Shape B
- 6. Shape F




Mark 2" gridlines as shown to assist with shape placement.

Tuck under edges of shapes where required.


Use coordinating thread to machine satin stitch or blanket stitch around the shapes. Press flat.

Sew Sashing Together

1. Sew 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing together with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing Squares as shown. Press towards the squares.



Repeat to make Sashing as shown.




3. Repeat to make Floral Sashing as shown.



Sewing the Main Units Block 1


1. Sew 1 ½" x 6 ½" Sashing to 6 ½" x 6 ½" squares to form rows. Press towards the 6 ½" squares.



Sew Sashing A to the rows as shown. Press the seams towards the rows




3. Sew Sashing C to the lower edge of a 13 ½" x 13 ½" fussy cut Peacock. Press towards the Peacock.



Sew the Step 2 unit to the peacock unit. Press towards the peacock unit.


Sew the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ " paisley border strip to the unit. Press towards the border.



Block 2

1. Sew 1 ½" x 6 ½" Sashing to 6 ½" x 6 ½" squares. Press towards the 6 ½" squares.


2. Sew Sashing B to the row as shown. Press the seam towards the sashing.



3. Sew a Sashing C to a 13 ½" x 13 ½" fussy cut peacock. Press the seam towards the peacock.





 Sew the Step 2 and 3 units together. Press the seam towards the sashing.




Block 3

1. Sew 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Press towards the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.







Sew Sashing B to the rows as shown. Press the seam towards the rows.



 Sew Sashing C to the side of a 13 ½" x 13 ½" fussy cut peacock.
Press towards the peacock.
Sew Sashing B to the top of the block. Press towards the peacock.




 Sew the step 2 and 3 units together. Press towards the peacock block.
Sew Floral Sashing E to the side.
Press towards the peacock block.




Block 4


1. Sew 1 ½" x 6 ½" Sashing to 6 ½" x 6 ½" squares. Press towards the 6 ½" squares.



Sew Sashing D to this unit.Press towards the row.



3. Sew the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ " border strip to the unit. Press towards the border strip.




Block 5

 Sew Sashing C to a 13 ½" x
½" peacock block. Press towards the peacock.




Block 6


Sew a Sashing C and a Floral Sashing E together.
Press towards the Floral Sashing.



2. Sew a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing strip to a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Paisley border strip. Press towards the border.




Sew the Step 1 and 2 units together. Press towards the border.




Joining the Blocks


1. Sew Block 1 and 2 together. Press to block 1.




2. Sew the appliqué block to block 3. Press towards the appliqué block.



3. Sew blocks 4 and 5 together. Press towards block 4.



3. Sew the step 2 and 3 units together. Press towards the step 3 unit. Sew block 6 to this unit. Press towards the appliqué. Sew the step 1 unit to the quilt. Press towards the step 1 unit. Sew the 6 ½" x 62 ½" border to the side. Press towards the border.



Finishing the Quilt

- 1. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Bind with the 2 1/2" Flower strips.
