Cutting (WOF = width of fabric)

Fabric Requirements

1/4 yard each:

G8555 Rose Gold, G8555 Pine Gold, G8555 Dusty Blue Gold (Blocks)

3/8 yard:

G8555 Burgundy Gold(blocks and sash)

2/3 yard each:

J8626 Onyx Gold, J8624 Onyx Gold (blocks)

3/4 yard:

J8627 Onyx Gold (setting triangles)

1 yard:

G8555 Ivory Gold (blocks and sash)

7/8 yards:

J8628 Onyx Gold (border 1 and binding)

1-3/4 yards

J8623 Onyx Gold (blocks & border 2)

3-1/8 yards any of the **Royal Gardens** collection for backing

61" x 75" batting

Template plastic

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

- All seams are sewn with 1/4" seams.
- HST refers to Half-Square Triangles. A square cut diagonally into two triangles.
- QST refers to Quarter-Square Triangles.
 A square cut twice diagonally into four triangles.
- Create your own templates with the drawings of Templates A, B, and C at the end of the pattern.

Blocks

G8555 Burgundy, G8555 Rose, G8555 Dusty Blue, and G8555 Pine

Cut eighteen from each with Template A.

G8555 Ivory

Cut eighteen with Template B.

J8624 Onyx

Cut **eight** 9-1/2" squares; fold in half diagonally then cut out quarter circle with **Template C** lined up on the square.

J8626 Onyx and J8623 Onyx

Cut **five** 9-1/2" squares each; fold in half diagonally then cut out the quarter circle with **Template C** lined up on the square.

Sash

G8555 Ivory

Cut **two** 9-1/2" strips WOF; sub-cut into (48) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles.

G8555 Burgundy

Cut (31) 1-1/2" squares.

Setting triangles and corners J8627 Onyx

Cut three 15-1/2" squares; sub-cut into ten QST. (You will have 12 but only use 10)
Cut two 8-3/4" squares; sub-cut into four HST. Cut one from bottom left to top right and the other from bottom right to top left with the print facing in the correct direction.

Borders and Binding J8628 Onyx

Cut **six** 1-1/2" strips WOF. Cut **seven** 2-1/4" strips WOF.

J8623 Onyx

Cut seven 5-1/2" strips WOF.


Block construction:

 Sew one Burgundy, Pine, Rose, and Dusty Blue Template A together, starting with two pairs of two then sew pairs together. Press seams in one direction. Make 18.






With Ivory Template B on top, match centers and ends and sew together.
 (This is a fairly gentle curve so no clips are necessary.)



Press toward center of block.


 With fabric Template C on top, match centers and ends and



Make eight with J8624 Onyx, five with J8623 Onyx, and five with J8626 Onyx.

Quilt construction

- 4. This quilt is set on-point. Lay out the blocks, 9-1/2" Ivory sash, 1-1/2" Burgundy cornerstones, and setting triangles following the fabric placement on the cover photo and the layout illustration below.
- 5. Sew in diagonal rows, alternating with a sash row and block row along with the 15-1/2" J8627 Onyx QSTs. (Check on the direction of the print to make sure the QST are going in the correct direction.) Sew sash rows and block rows together. Press sash rows sash and block rows to sash. Sew on 8-3/4" J8627 Onyx HSTs last. (Check on the direction of the HST to make sure the print is going in the correct direction. Press seams in opposite directions.



Square off corners and trim edges if necessary.



Border construction

- 6. Sew the **six** 1-1/2" **J8628 Onyx** strips, short ends together, with diagonal seams. Measure through the vertical center (top to bottom)and trim **two** to this measurement. Pin,matching centers and ends, and sew to sides of quilt. Press to border.
- 7. Measure through the horizontal center (side to side) and trim remaining 1 1/2" strip to **two** border widths and sew to top and bottom.
- Repeat steps 13 and 14 with the seven 5-1/2" J8623 Onyx strips.

Cut the 3-1/8 yards of backing into two equal pieces. Trim off selvages and sew selvage edges together. Place on quilt with seam going horizontally.

Layer, quilt, and bind with the **seven** 2-1/4" **J8628 Onyx** binding strips, sewn, short ends together, with diagonal seams, using a French binding technique.

Remember to put a label on the back and ENJOY!
