## On Track

**Rush Hour** quilt by Heidi Pridemore featuring the On Track collection by Jill McDonald for P&B Textiles

Quilt Size: 64" x 84"

### Yardage

Fabric A	OTRA 351 MU	$1  ^{1/2}$ yards
Fabric B	OTRA 354 MU	10 blocks (2 rows)
Fabric C	OTRA 359 RO	1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yards
Fabric D	OTRA 355 K	1/2 yard
Fabric E	OTRA 357 W	1/2 yard
Fabric F	OTRA 359 G	<sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yard
Fabric G	OTRA 359 B	3/8 yard
Fabric H	OTRA 358 K	1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> yards
Fabric I	OTRA 353 B	3 yards
Backing	any OTRA fabric	5 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yards

### Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A (OTRA 351 MU), fussy cut:

• (1) 26 1/2" x 46 1/2" lengthwise center panel

Fabric B (OTRA 354 MU), fussy cut:

• (10) 7 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares

Fabric C (OTRA 359 RO), cut:

- (2) 7 1/2" x 42" strips; cut into (20) 3" x 7 1/2" rectangles
- (2) 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42" strips;
  cut into (20) 3" x 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles

Fabric D (OTRA 355 K), cut:

(2) 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42" strips; cut into (12) 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares

Fabric E (OTRA 357 W), cut:

• (2) 5 1/2" strips; cut into (12) 5 1/2" squares

Fabric F (OTRA 359 G), cut:

• (3) 3" x 42" strips

Fabric G (OTRA 359 B), cut:

• (3) 3" x 42" strips

Fabric H (OTRA 358 K), cut:

- (3) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42" strips. Piece the strips and cut
  (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 46 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips.
- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 30 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips
- (7) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42" strips. Piece the strips and cut (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 70 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips and (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 54 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x 42" binding strips

Fabric I (OTRA 353 B), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 74 1/2" lengthwise border strips
- (4) 5 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece the strips and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 64 1/2" border strips.

#### **Block Assembly**

Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement guidance throughout.

- **1.** Sew 3" x 7 1/2" Fabric C rectangles to opposite sides of a Fabric B square. Sew 3" x 12 1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of the square to make a block. Trim the block to measure 10 1/2" square. Make a total of 10 blocks.
- 2. Join a Fabric F strip and a Fabric G strip along their long edges to make a strip set. Make a total of three strip sets. Crosscut the strip sets into 32 segments, 3" wide.
- **3.** Join two segments from step 2 to make a four-patch unit. The unit should measure 5 \(^1/\_2\)" square. Make a total of 16 units.

NOTE: On steps 4–11, pay attention to the vertical alignment of the pieces.

**4.** Join two four-patch units, one Fabric D square, and one Fabric E square to make a block as shown. The block should measure 10 1/2" square. Make a total of four blocks.



**5.** Repeat step 4 to make four blocks as shown.



**G.** Join two Fabric D squares and two Fabric E squares to make a block as shown. The block should measure 10 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square. Repeat to make a second block.




### **Quilt Top Assembly**

Refer to the quilt photo and quilt layout diagram for placement guidance throughout.

- **7.** Sew 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric H strips to opposite sides of the Fabric A center panel. Sew 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" Fabric H strips to the top and bottom of the center panel.
- 3. Join two blocks from step 2, one block from step 4, one block from step 5, and one block from step 6 to make a side border strip. Make a second side border. Sew the border strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top.

- Join two blocks from step 2, one block from step 4, and one block from step 5 to make the top border strip. Repeat to make the bottom border strip. Sew the border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- **10.** Sew  $2^{1/2}$ " x  $70^{1/2}$ " Fabric H strips to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew  $2^{1/2}$ " x  $54^{1/2}$ " Fabric H strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $74\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strips to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- **12.** Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the Fabric H binding strips, bind the edges to finish.




